

Week 1 – Why a Catechism? Why Now?

- GMC Catechism:
 - Introductory “Statement of Purpose” before Q1 (what a catechism is and why GMC wrote one).
- Key Scriptures (NIV):
 - Deuteronomy 6:4–9; 2 Timothy 1:13–14; 2 Timothy 2:2 (passing on sound teaching).

Week 2 – God the Creator (in, through, and for Christ)

- GMC Questions:
 - Q1 – Do you believe in God?
 - Q2 – Who is God?
 - Q5 – What is God’s relation to heaven and earth?
 - Q9 – What is the Son’s role in creation?
- Key Scriptures (NIV):
 - Genesis 1:1; Psalm 90:2; Acts 17:24–25.
 - Colossians 1:15–17; Hebrews 1:1–4.

Week 3 – The Trinity: One God, Three Persons

- GMC Questions:
 - Q3 – What is the mystery of the Trinity?
 - Q4 – Who is the Father?
 - Q6 – Who is the Son?
 - Q7 – Who is the Holy Spirit?
- Key Scriptures (NIV):
 - Matthew 28:19; 2 Corinthians 13:14.
 - John 1:1–3; Acts 5:3–4.

Week 4 – Jesus Christ: True (God and True Man)

- GMC Questions:

- Q6 – Who is the Son? (revisited, Christ's divine identity).
- Q8 – What is the relationship between the Son and the Father?
- Any Christology questions that echo “for us and for our salvation he came down from heaven” (check Christ section in your PDF).

- Key Scriptures (NIV):

- John 1:14; Philippians 2:5–11; Colossians 2:9.

- Romans 3:21–26; Ephesians 2:1–9; 2 Corinthians 5:21.

Week 6 – Resurrection, Ascension, and Christ's Return

- GMC Questions:

- Christology questions echoing “on the third day he rose again... he ascended... he will come again in glory” (Christ section).
- Q77 – What is the final work of grace in us? (resurrection/glorification, used here and again in Week 12).

- Key Scriptures (NIV):

- 1 Corinthians 15:3–8, 20–26; Acts 1:9–11; Revelation 21:1–5.

Week 5 – Sin, the Cross, and Salvation by Grace

- GMC Questions:

- Q45 – What is sin?
- Q46 – What is our condition apart from God's grace?
- Q49 – How does God save us?
- Q56–57 – Christ's atoning sacrifice and its scope.

- Key Scriptures (NIV):

Week 7 – The Holy Spirit: New Birth and Holiness

- GMC Questions:
 - Q7 – Who is the Holy Spirit?
 - Q61 – Is salvation only pardon and assurance?
 - Q62–64 – Questions on regeneration, new birth, and the beginning of sanctification (see “Wesleyan characteristics” section).
- Key Scriptures (NIV):
 - John 3:5–8; Titus 3:4–7; Galatians 5:16–25.

- 2 Timothy 3:16–17; 2 Peter 1:20–21; Psalm 19:7–11.

Week 9 – The Church: One, Holy, Catholic, Apostolic

- GMC Questions:
 - Q31 – What is the Church?
 - Q32 – What is the Church’s mission?
 - Q33 – Why is it necessary for Christians to gather for worship?
- Key Scriptures (NIV):
 - Ephesians 2:19–22; Ephesians 4:1–6, 11–16; Acts 2:42–47.

Week 8 – Holy Scripture: Authority and Sufficiency

- GMC Questions:
 - Q34 – How does God reveal himself to us today?
 - Q35 – What is Holy Scripture?
 - Q36–37 – Inspiration and role of Scripture in the life of the church.
- Key Scriptures (NIV):

Week 10 – The Sacraments: Baptism and the Lord’s Supper

- GMC Questions:
 - Q38 – What are the Sacraments?
 - Q39 – Why are the Sacraments important?
 - Q40 – How many Sacraments are there?
 - Q41–43 – Baptism (meaning, subjects, mode).
 - Q44 – The Lord’s Supper (presence and grace).
- Key Scriptures (NIV):
 - Matthew 28:19–20; Romans 6:3–4 (baptism).
 - 1 Corinthians 11:23–26; Luke 22:14–20 (Lord’s Supper).

- Q68–72 – Questions on obedience, means of grace, and life of holiness (scan this cluster in your text).
- Key Scriptures (NIV):
 - Romans 12:1–2; Galatians 5:13–26; Hebrews 12:14.

Week 12 – Last Things: Judgment, Resurrection, New Creation

- GMC Questions:
 - Q73–77 – Final judgment, hope, and glorification; especially Q77 on the final work of grace in us.
- Key Scriptures (NIV):
 - 2 Corinthians 5:10; 1 Thessalonians 4:13–18; Revelation 20:11–15; Revelation 21:1–4.

- GMC Questions:
 - Q61–63 – Salvation as more than pardon: regeneration and holiness.
